PROFESSIONAL SERVICE OR VOLUNTEER WORK

Grace Bible Church, Nacogdoches, TX. Program Coordinator, approximately 150 hours spent for the year, (August 1, 2021 - December 31, 2023).

Activity Description

Independent study to prepare for leading a group of women (multigenerational). Discussion leader's meet 45 mins per week to further prepare for 1.5 hour weekly small group Bible study. Equipping women of all ages to study the Bible.

Activity Description

Large local youth program that relies on volunteer coaches and "team managers" to provide baseball training and games at a low cost to families.

I served as "team manager" for both a 9/10 and 7/8 team during the 2021 season and a 11/12 and 7/8 team during the 2022 season. As "team manager", I coordinated with parents and

coaches to ensure the children were receiving high quality instruction in a safe and encouraging environment.

Activity Description

Ensure preschool age children are safe and cared for while their parents attend Bible study and/or church services. Supervise college volunteers. Lead activities to stimulate speech and language development. Consult with parents regarding feeding, swallowing and/or communication concerns. Evaluate and treat at no cost to families if indicated.
